

- Paraprofessionals must be at least *19 years of age* to serve students in pre-kindergarten through grade 12.
- Beginning January 1, 2023, you may qualify for the ELS-Paraprofessional license by meeting the requirements at age 18 **BUT** only serve in pre-kindergarten through grade 8.
- All paraprofessionals MUST work under the direct supervision of a licensed teacher.

## Getting Ready for the Test

If you do not have 60 semester hours or an Associate Degree or Higher, a high school diploma or GED along with a passing score on the Paraprofessional Test can be used instead.

There are two tests included with the \$50.00 Paraprofessional Testing fee:

- <u>ACT WorkKeys Applied Math Test</u>
- <u>ACT WorkKeys Workplace Documents</u>

Study materials can be found for each test respectively by clicking on the links above with difficulty ratings 3-7. Sample Items can be found for each level of difficulty, and detailed feedback on responses you provide will appear as you answer the questions.

You MUST complete both the Google Form AND the Registration Form to schedule your test
